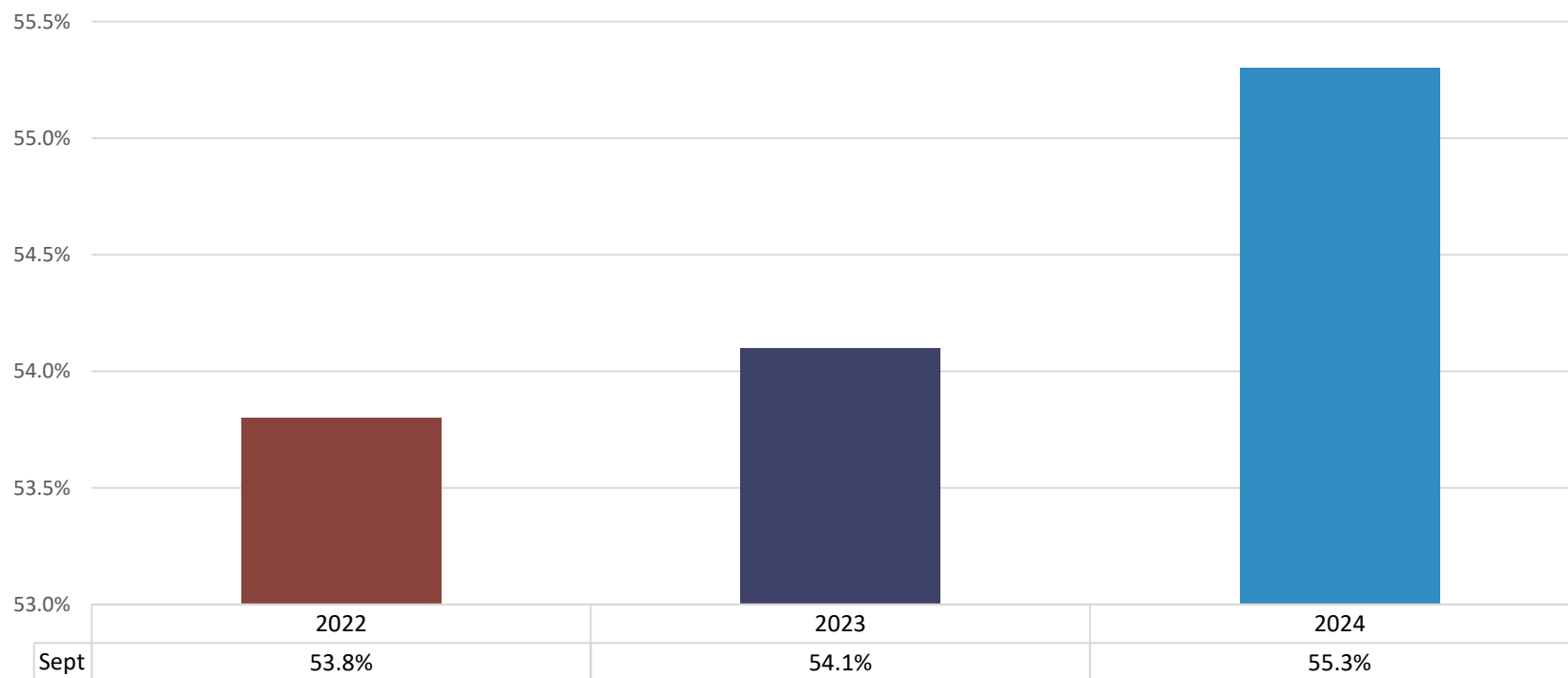

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Louisiana Lodging

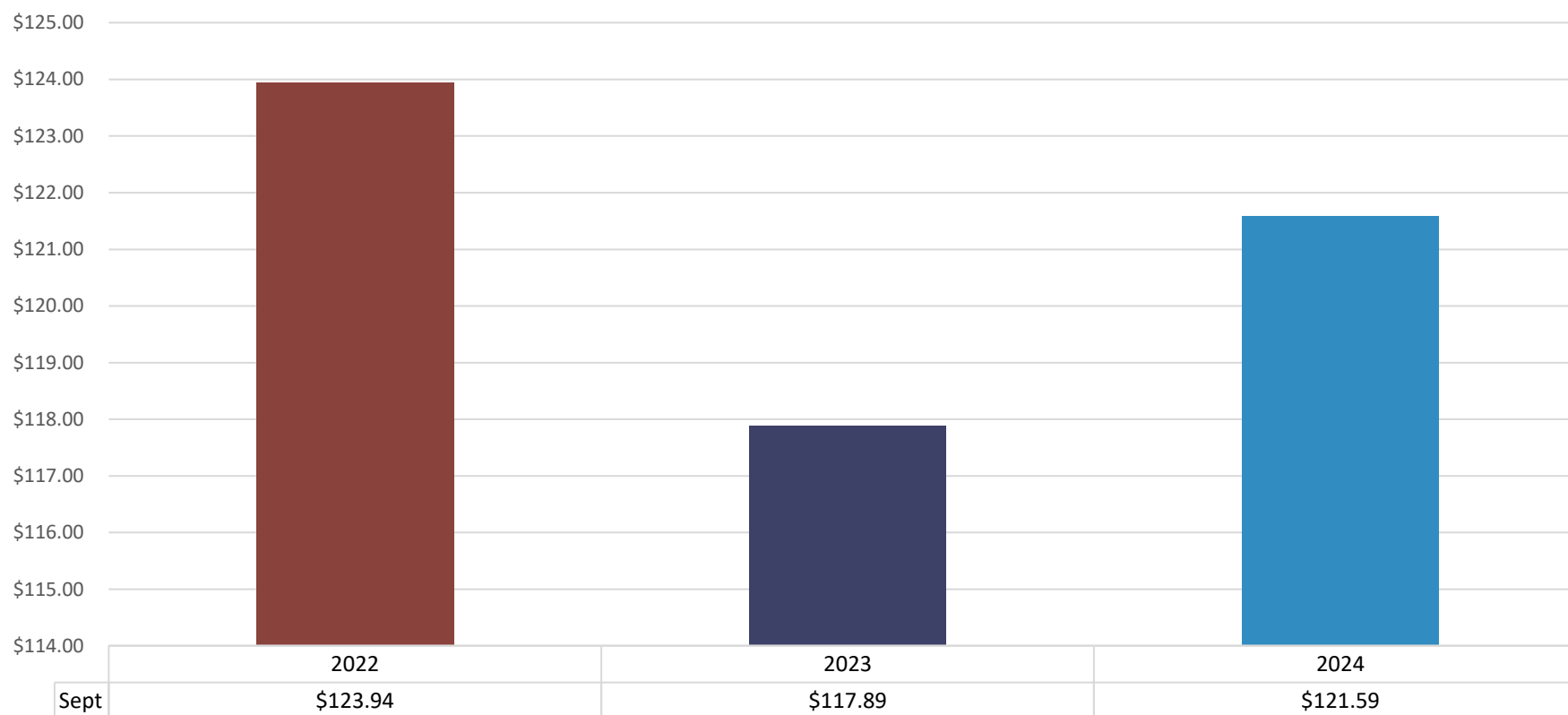
September Occupancy (%): Yr/Yr

- Year-to-date, occupancy is up 2.5%.

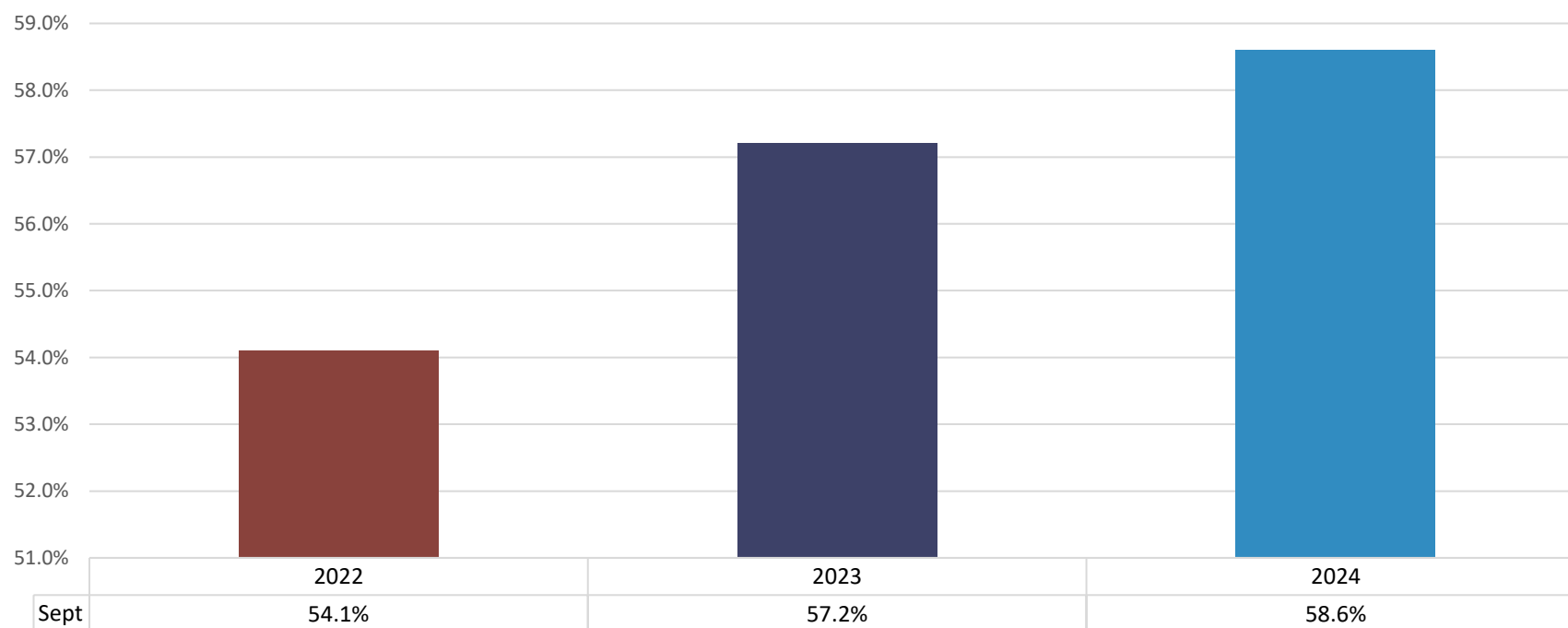


- Louisiana's average daily rates (ADR) grew 3.1% over September 2023.

Louisiana Lodging (without New Orleans)

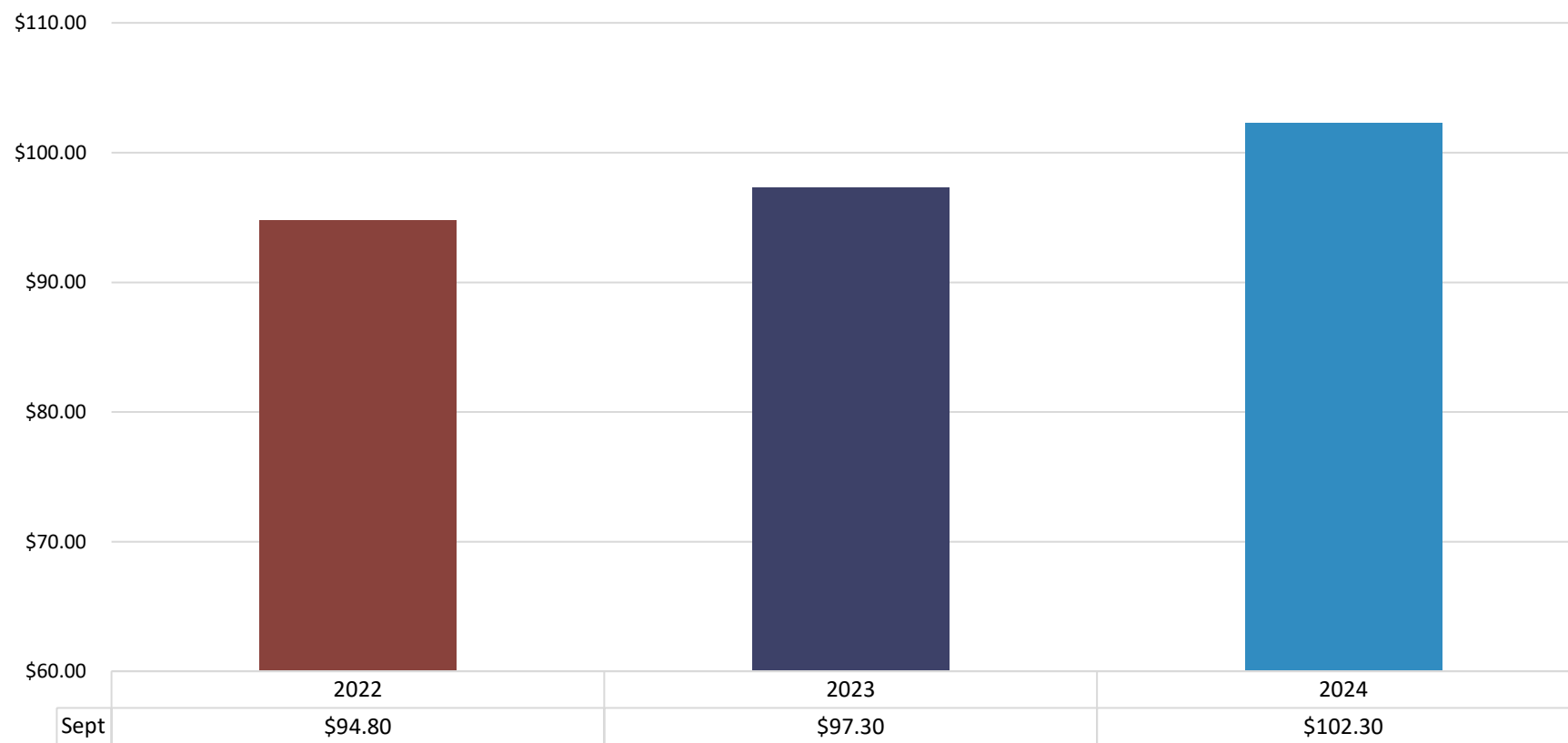
September Occupancy (%) without NOLA: Yr/Yr

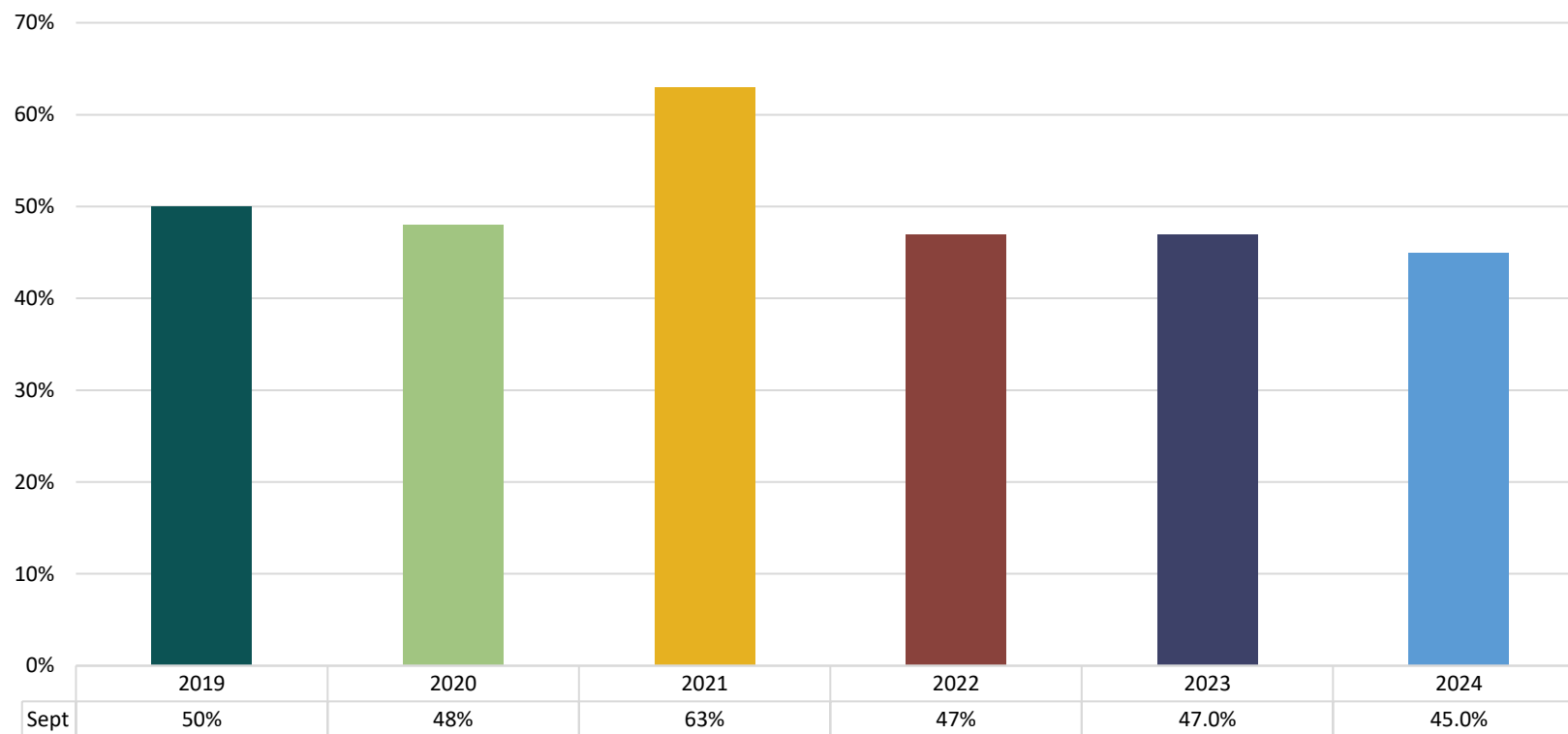


- Louisiana's ADR, excluding New Orleans, grew by 5.1% over September 2023.

Louisiana Short-Term Lodging

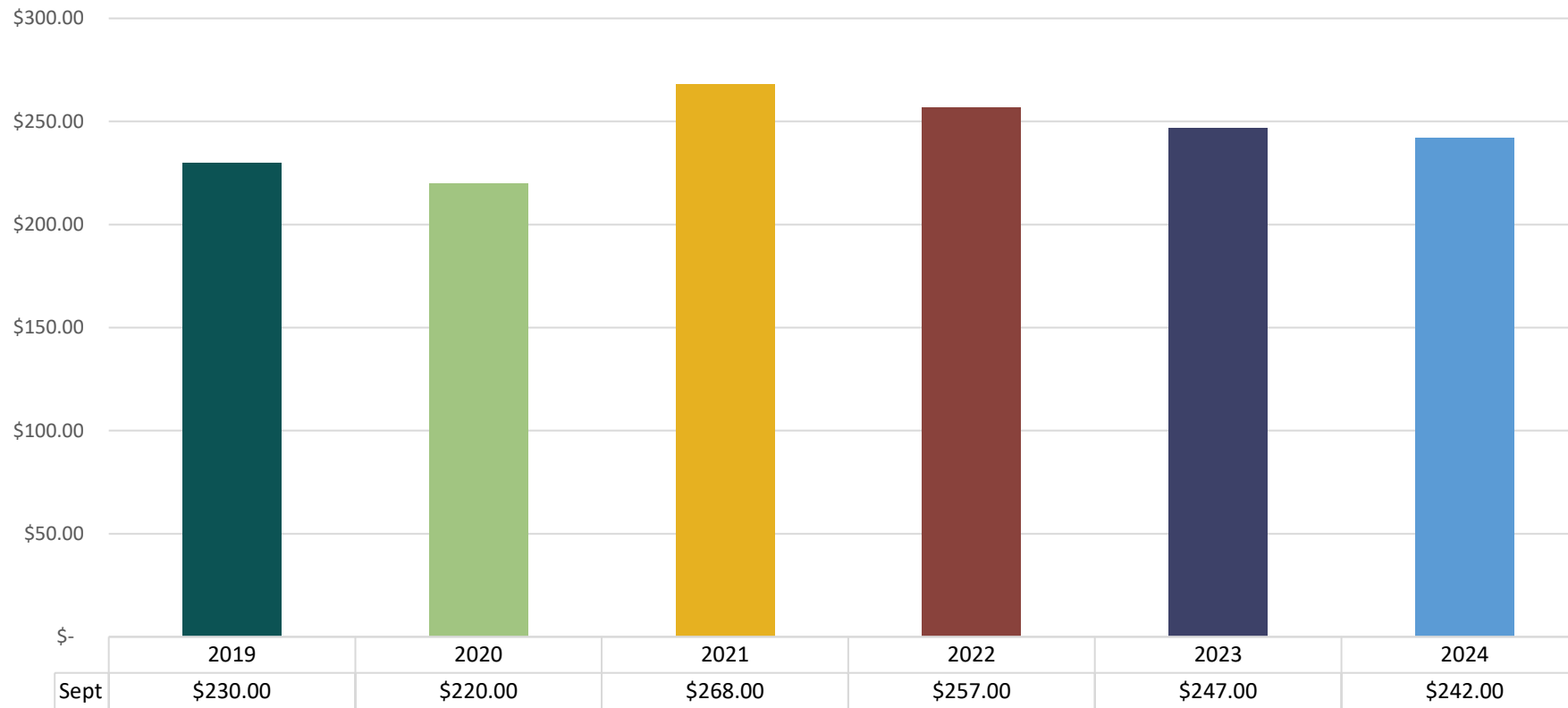
September Short-Term Rental Occupancy (%): Yr/Yr

September Short-Term Rental ADR (\$): Yr/Yr

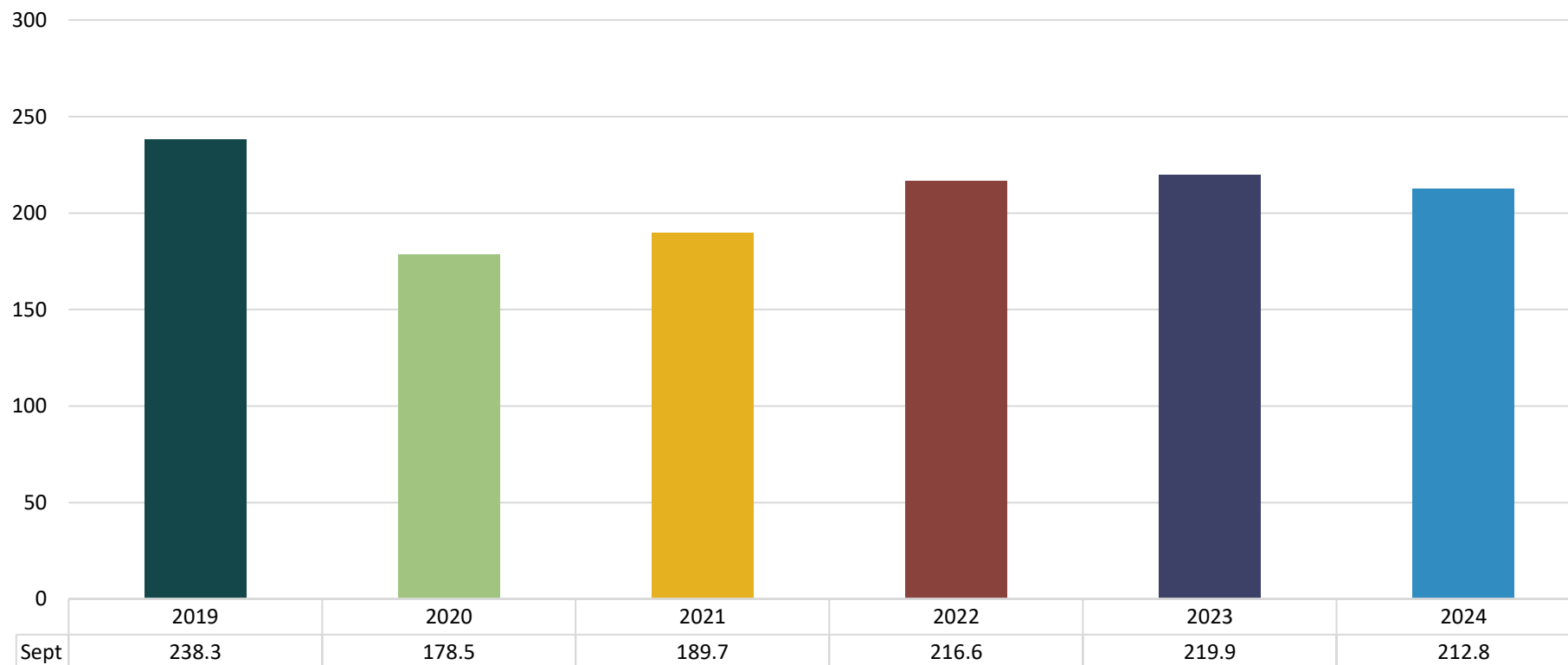


- Louisiana's short-term lodging ADR was down 2% over September 2023.

September Tourism Jobs (in thousands): Yr/ Yr

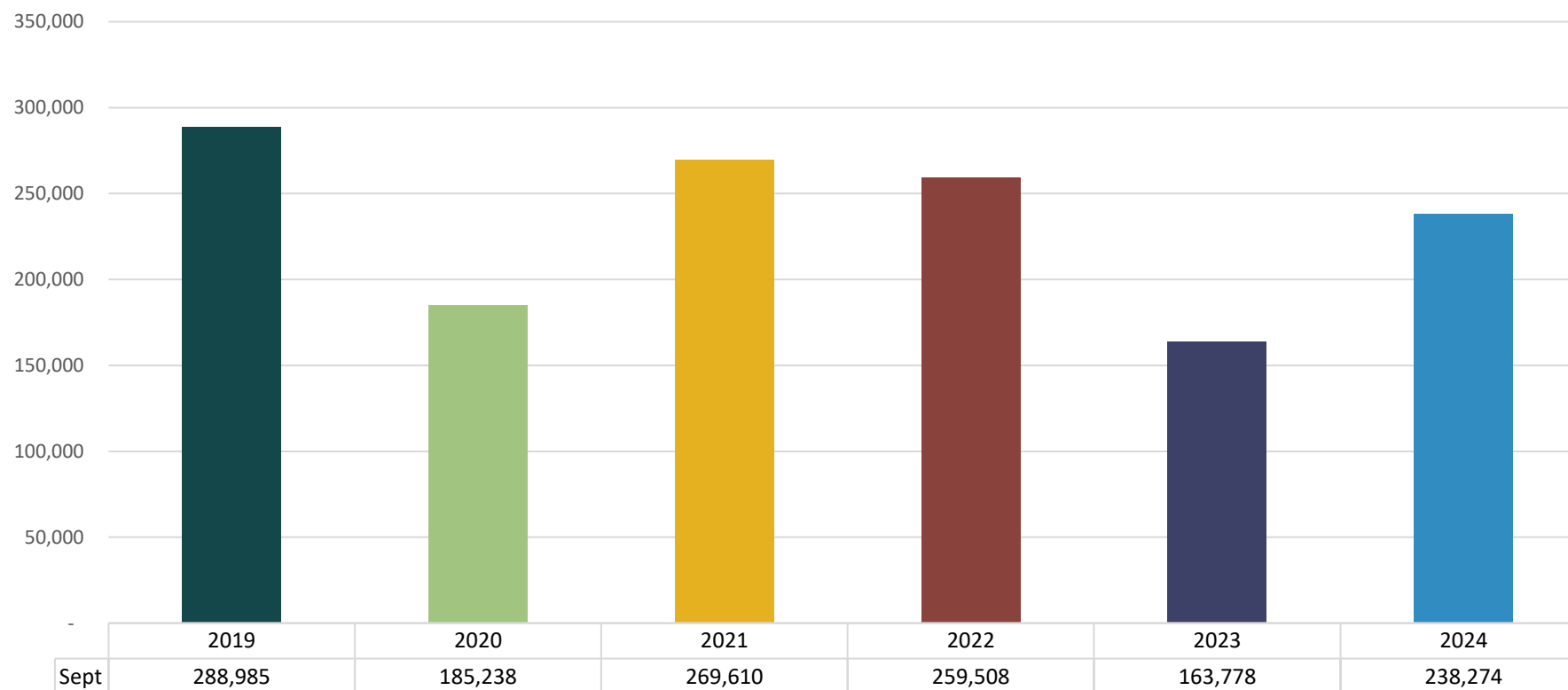


- Arts, Entertainment and Recreation jobs are flat month over month.

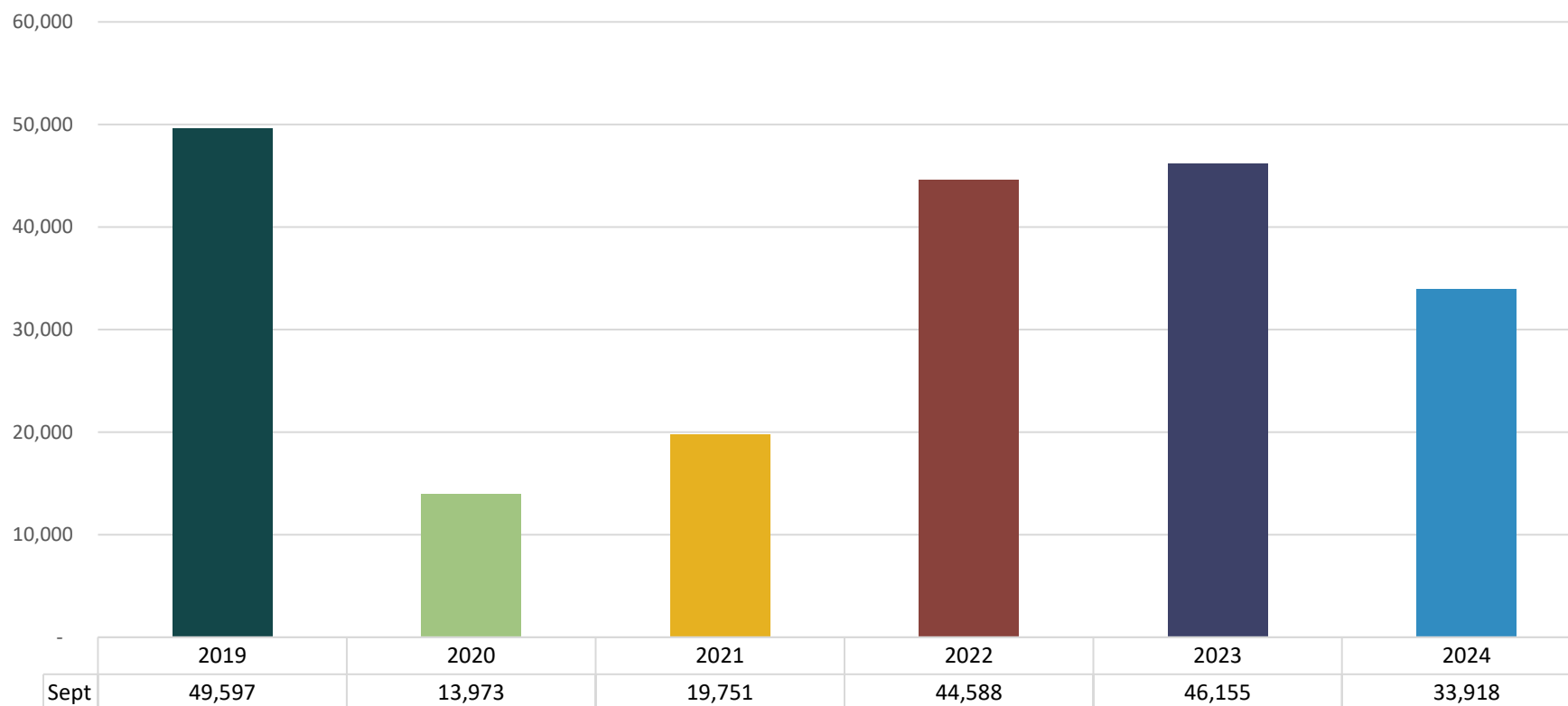


- Sessions are up 45% over September 2023.

September Welcome Centers Visitation: Yr/Yr

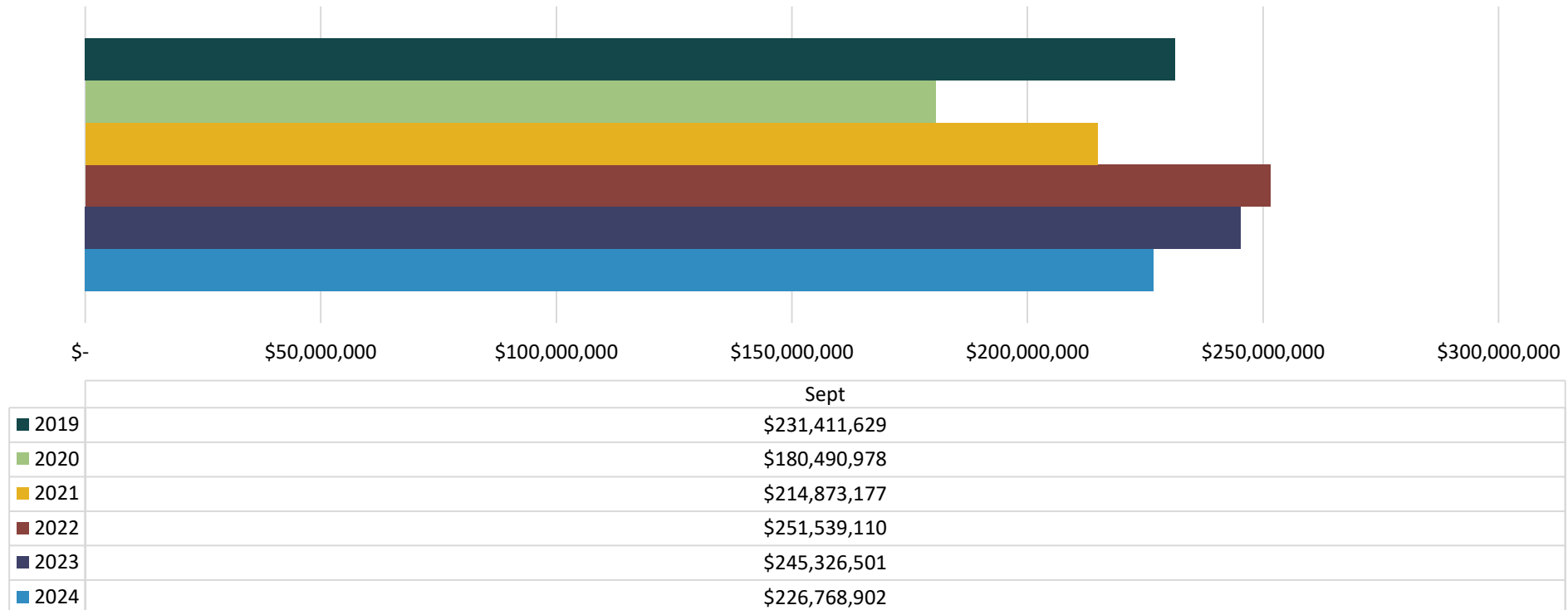


- Louisiana welcome centers welcomed 5,910 visitors from international countries in September.

- Louisiana's gaming revenue decreased 7.6% over September 2023.
- Revenue was up 5.9% in August over August 2023.

U.S. Travel Sentiment & Trends

- Over a quarter (27.7%) of American travelers said they expect to take more trips in the next 12 months compared to the last 12 months. *(Future Partners)*
- In the past year, 1-in-4 American travelers say they have traveled specifically to attend a sporting event. *(Future Partners)*
- Amtrak route between New Orleans and Mobile is coming back in 2025 and will run twice daily and include stops in four cities in Mississippi: Pascagoula, Biloxi, Gulfport, and Bay St. Louis. *(Amtrak)*
- Travelers that take road trips stay 5 nights or more (28%), spend 45% more, and visit 3 or more states (67%). *(Longwoods)*
- \$50+ billion direct spending by U.S. road trip travelers with over 137 million road trips in the U.S. *(Longwoods)*
- 55% of travelers expect to spend about the same on holiday travel this year, up from 49% in 2023. *(Longwoods)*
- The U.S. retains its position as the world's largest travel market after garnering a whopping \$476 billion in bookings. That figure is more than three times the size of second-ranked China. *(Phocuswright)*
