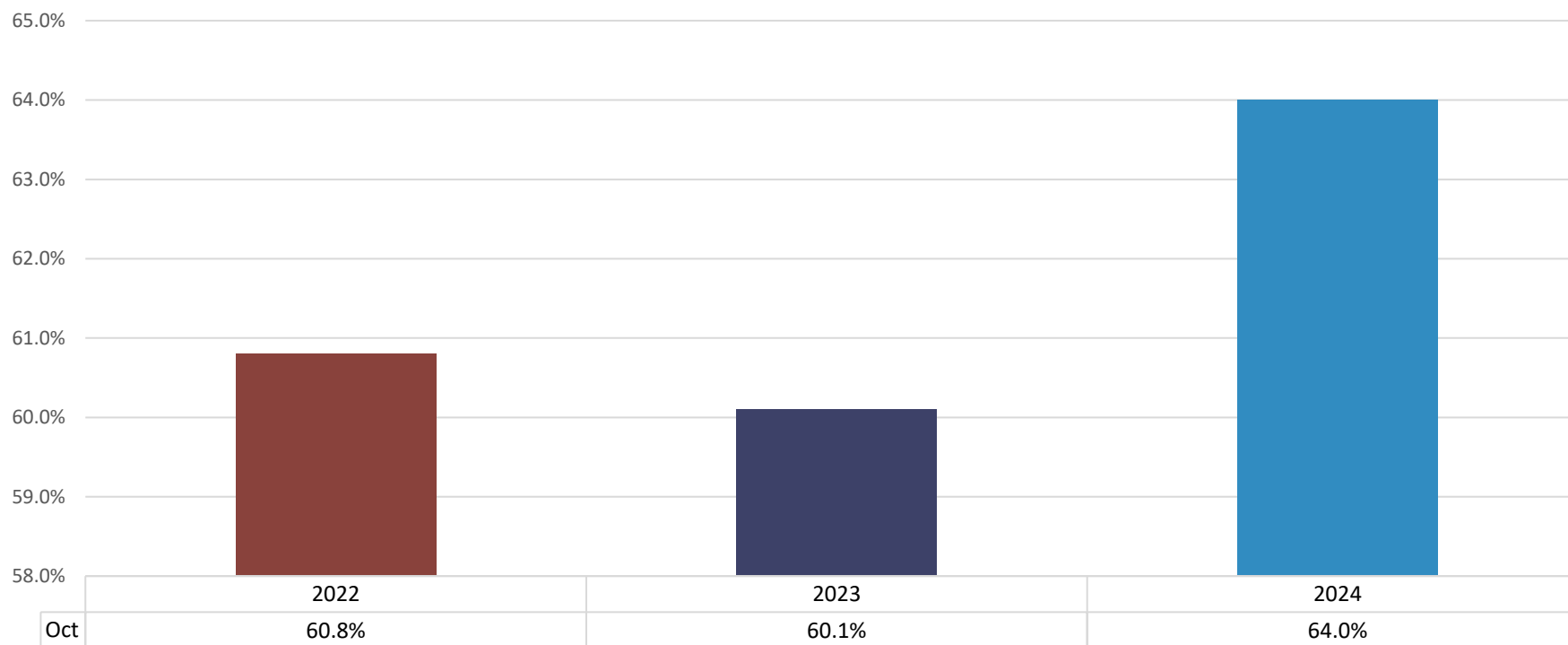

Louisiana Lodging

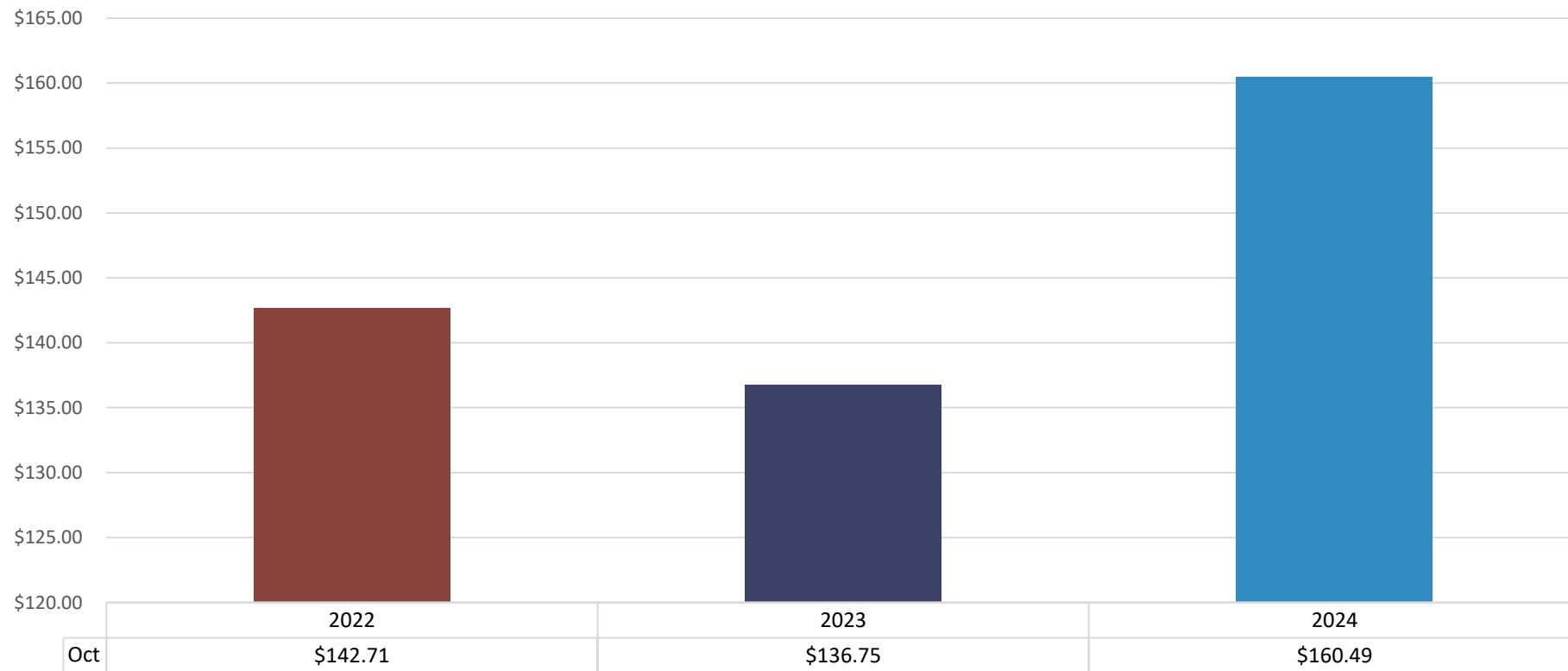
October Occupancy (%): Yr/Yr

- Year-to-date, occupancy is up 2.8%.

October ADR (\$): Yr/Yr

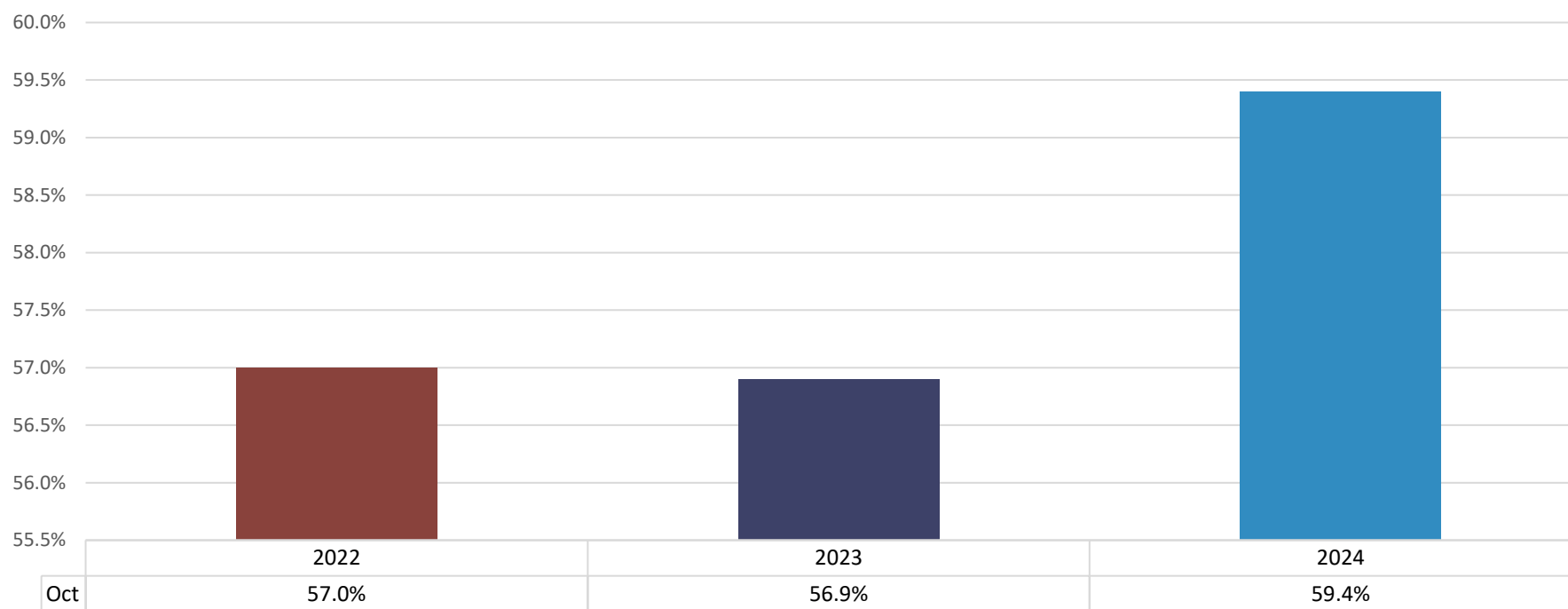


- Louisiana's average daily rates (ADR) grew 17.4% over October 2023.

Louisiana Lodging (without New Orleans)

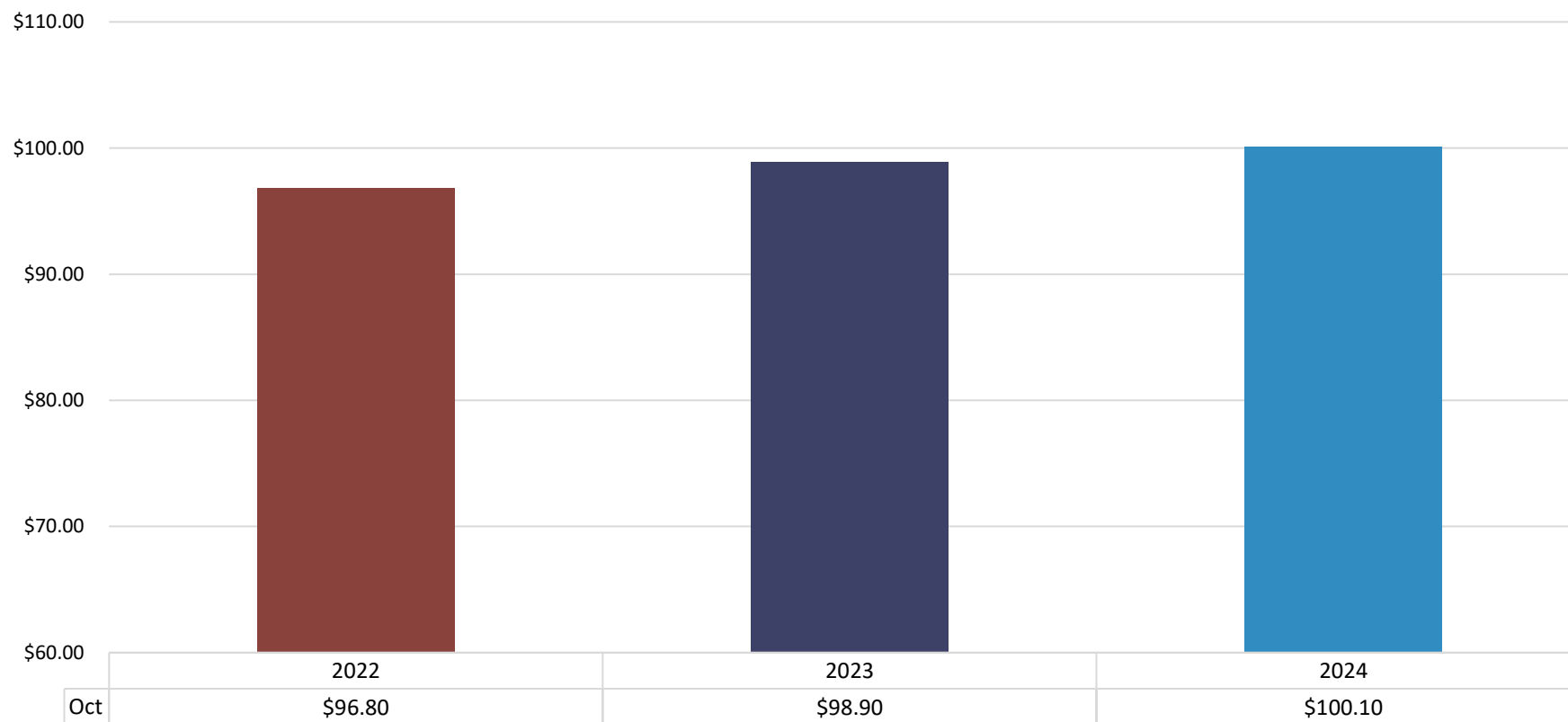
October Occupancy (%) without NOLA: Yr/Yr

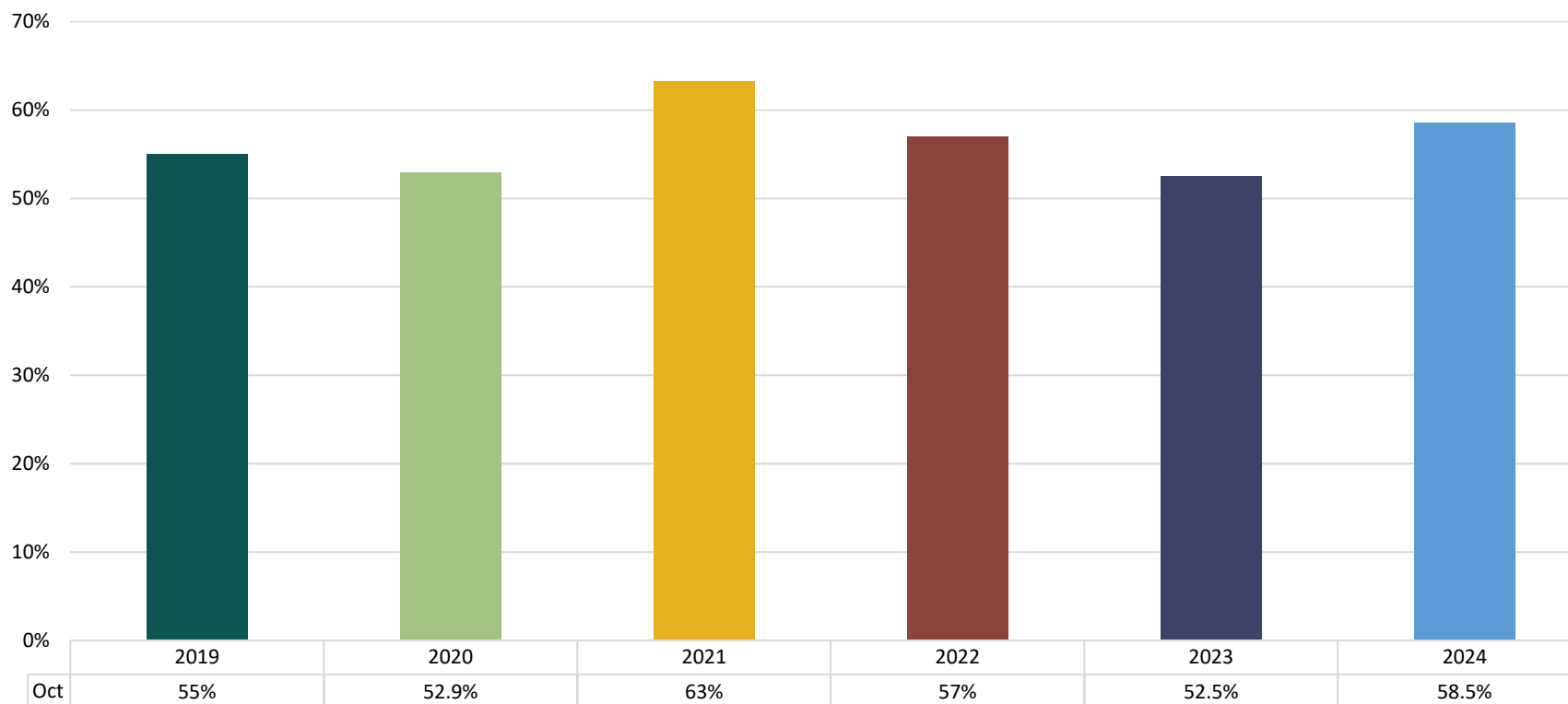


- Louisiana's ADR, excluding New Orleans, grew by 1.2% over October 2023.

Louisiana Short-Term Lodging

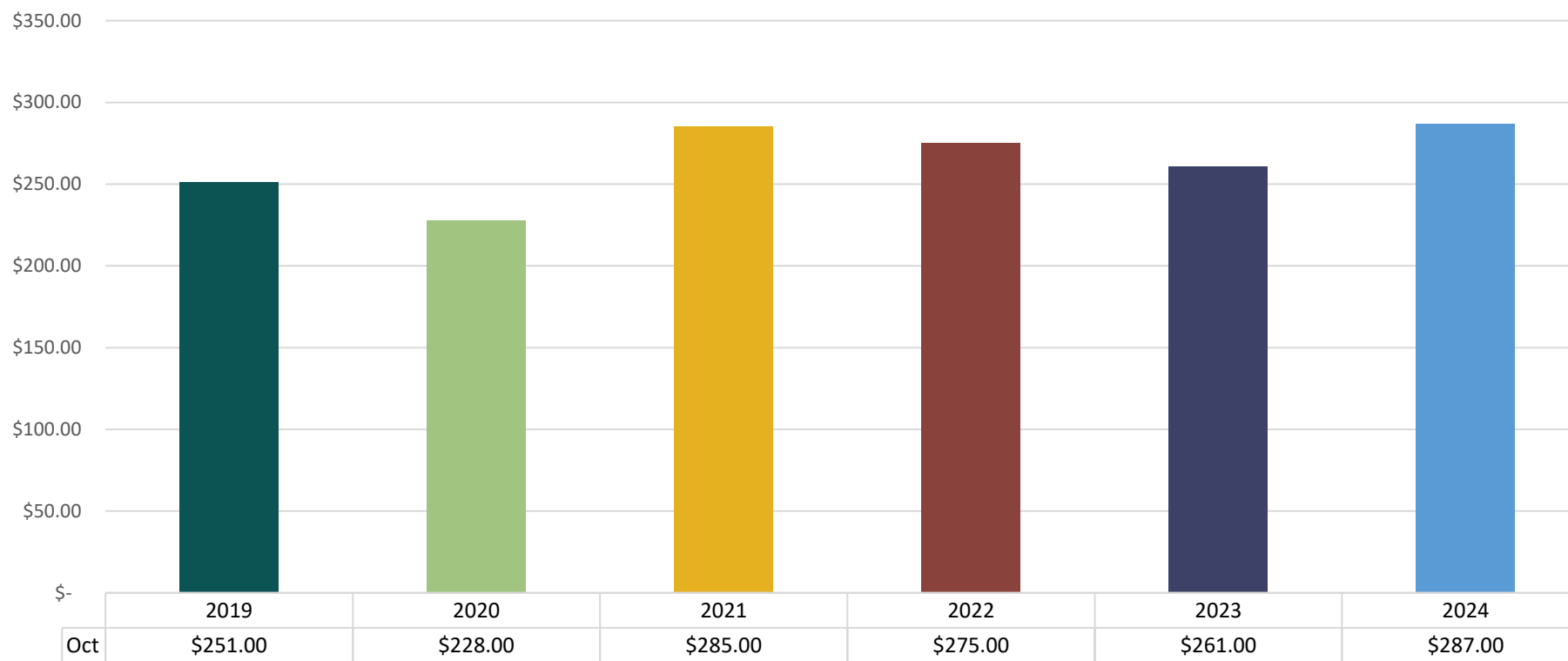
October Short-Term Rental Occupancy (%): Yr/Yr

October Short-Term Rental ADR (\$): Yr/Yr

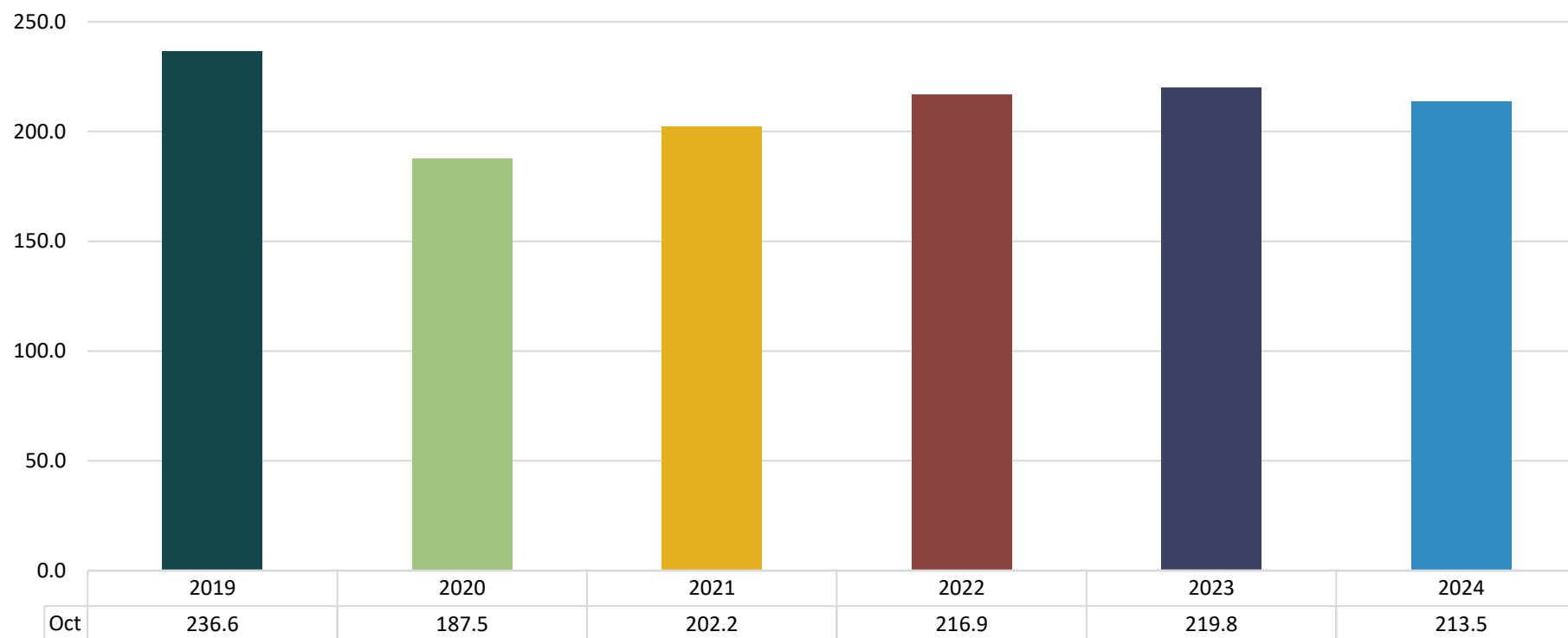


- Louisiana's short-term lodging ADR grew 10% over October 2023.

October Tourism Jobs (in thousands): Yr/ Yr

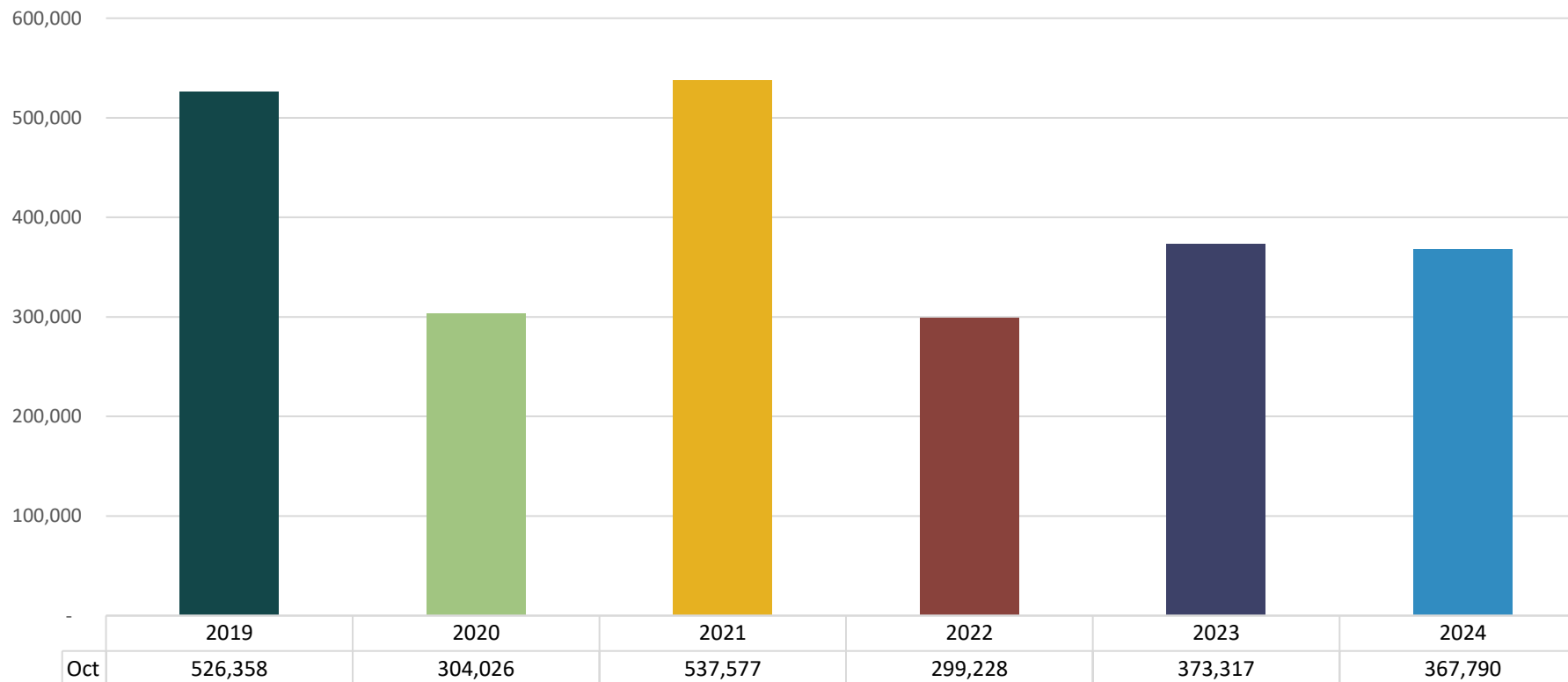


- Arts, Entertainment and Recreation jobs gained 400 jobs over last month and grew 0.7% over last year.

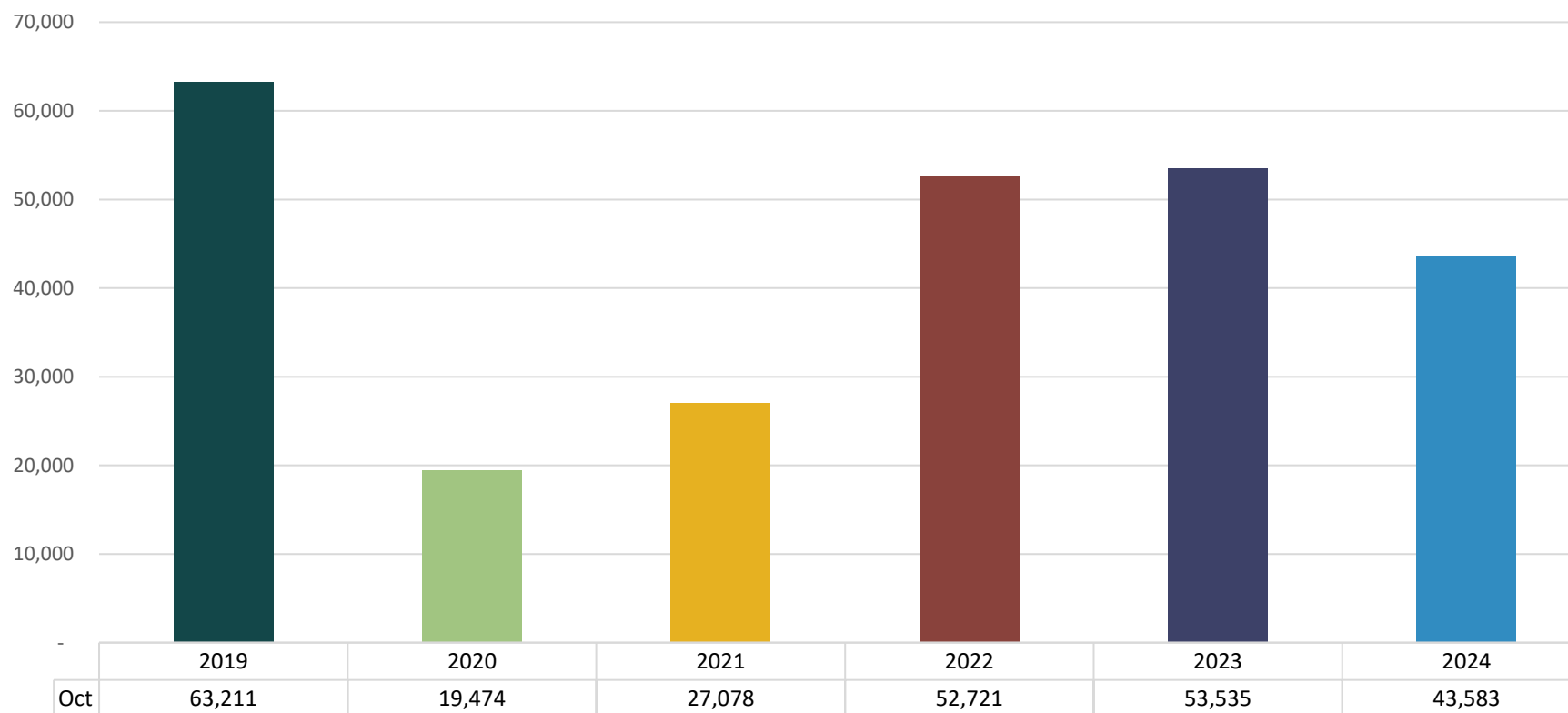


- Views are up 5% over October 2023.

October Welcome Centers Visitation: Yr/Yr

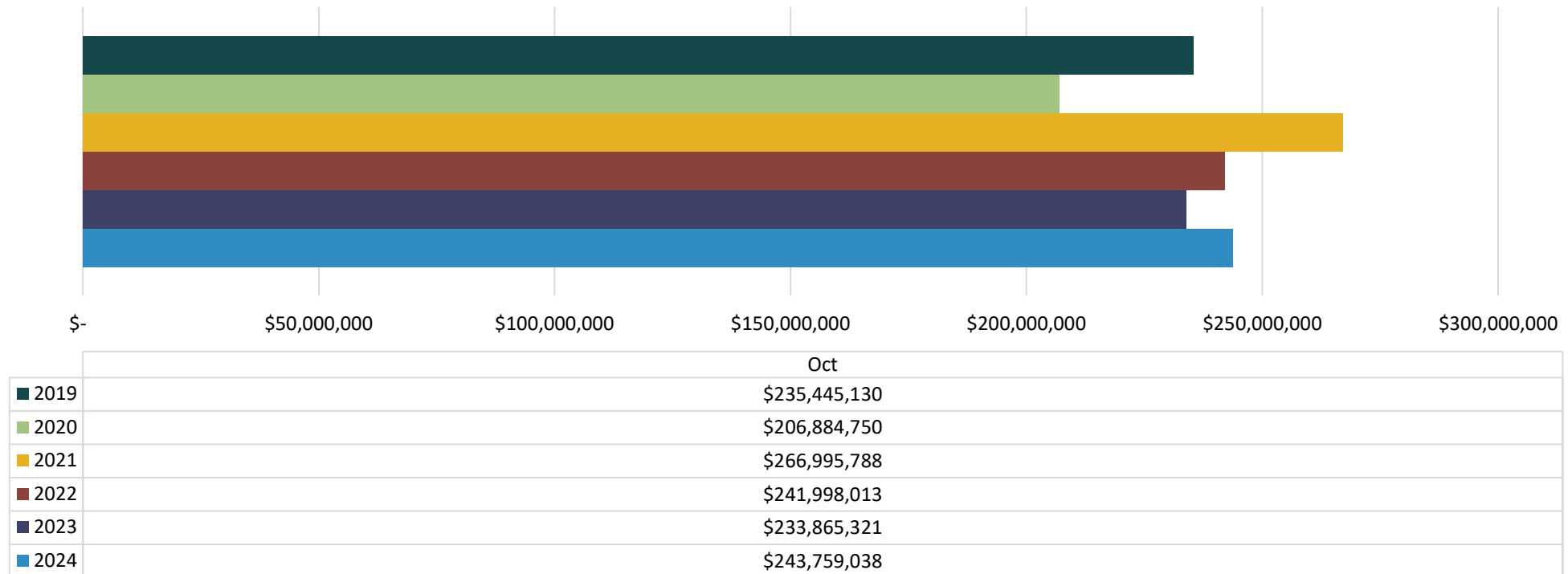


- Louisiana welcome centers welcomed nearly 600 visitors from France, 42% increase, over last October.

U.S. Travel Sentiment & Trends

- 29% of American travelers said they expect to travel more for leisure in the coming 12 months. *(Future Partners)*
- Almost 80 million people are expected to travel (roads and air) over Thanksgiving in record-breaking getaway. An estimated increase of 1.7 million from last year and 2 million more than in 2019. *(AAA)*
- People travel for their passions like for food, particular restaurants, yoga or sports - people are traveling for big sporting events with groups. *(Amex Travel)*
- 2025 is set to be a transformative year in the travel industry. It will focus on intentional journeys that enrich travelers' lives and deepen their connections to both people and the places they visit. *(Priceline)*
- Over two in five Americans (44%) are now traveling once or twice a year - higher than the corresponding figure in October 2023 (38%). *(YouGov)*
- Visa wait times reduced by nearly 60% since pandemic peak. *(US Travel)*
- Millennials and Gen Z (1997-2012) take more trips than any other generation, with many opting for three or more leisure trips a year. *(CNBC Travel)*
